We split the information already received in previous research into four categories and the top suggestions are below:

**Being a Good Neighbour:** The majority's suggestion was to hold more community picnics and community parties.

**Safe and Clean Neighbourhood:** Top suggestions with equal importance were to put fencing around the play area and a dog fouling campaign in Elmfield Park.

**Making Ends Meet:** Top suggestions were to set up a skill based educational program for the community and an 'Incredible Edible' project.

**Things to Do and Places to Go:** Top suggestions, setting up a community Café / Kitchen and improving children's play facilities in the area.
